



Wednesday 4th July

On Wednesday three significant events took place. The first was the consecration of a prayer house which was set aside as a place of prayer similar to Moses' tabernacle where the Glory of the Lord would settle whenever Moses went to prayer. The second was a hilltop where the chiefs of the province were anointed. Specific prayer for the cleansing of all occult practices on the hilltops was offered from ancient days up to the present including Masonic rituals and curses. A prayer for restoration in the land was offered by Dr Bush and Ps. Inosi Vono. This prayer for Restoration officially launched Transformation Fiji which is the 7 year vision to see every village in Fiji experience Transformation by 4th July 2017. One intercessor saw the cloud of Glory descend on the mountaintop just as it did on the Mount of Transfiguration.

At the prayer tower just up the hill from the site of the investiture of civil authority in the first chief of Fiji, we met the captain of the rugby team of Fiji, and now he is captaining the prayer tower overseeing the spiritual flow of the reversal acted out in this prophetic act.



Luis Bush prayed to release the power of the Holy Spirit on the 1st Hill on the boundaries of Lawai, where the Fijian prayer group hold their regular prayers, and on the second Hill where the 1st chief of the province of Nadroga/Navosa was first installed.



After this the whole delegation went to the chiefly village of Cuvu. The place where we prayed for the chief is called Naqeledamu, where only the chiefly family resides, and the park is called Lawaqa Park. After waiting for several hours the delegates were then received formally by two chiefs, Ratu Sakusa Makuta and Ratu Latinara. Protocol was followed and the chiefs were formally presented with the traditional gifts of Kava and whale tooth.

Henrick Minder from Switzerland also presented a splendid Swiss knife (normally presented to heads of State). Particular implements on the knife were emphasized with great humor representing different aspects of good leadership but with the challenge to honor Jesus as King of Kings in all their decisions.



Following this there was a traditional protocol of sharing a cup of kava. This respect given to the local custom of respecting the authority of the chiefs and sharing in their cultural forms of honoring one another opened up great blessings. Two intercessors smelt the presence of the Lord enter the room. Luis Bush and a number of other leaders were asked to pray over one of the chiefs, and a time of prophetic utterance was given right in front of the chiefly seats of authority.





In the evening Luis Bush concluded his series on Jacob as he reentered the Promised Land. The major obstacle for his return was not his brother Esau but his own fleshly nature. But Israel was able to cross the Jordan. Jacob had a new name, it was a new day, and Jacob, now Israel, had a new walk. The old fleshly Jacob was now a new spiritual nation Israel. The challenge was "God wants to use your life to change Fiji"

Luis Bush on his last night of sharing spoke from the book of Habakkuk, on the theme from Jakarta: "A new wave is coming".
