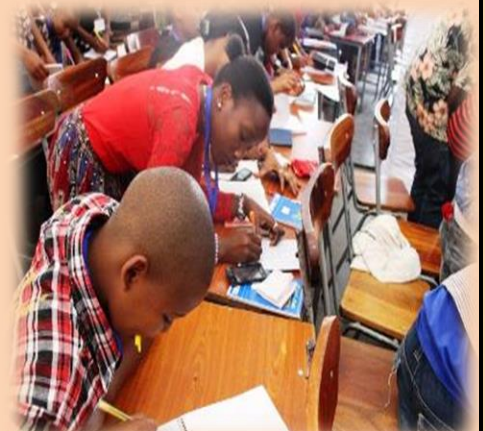




Africa
