### **ZIMBABWE**

Here in Zimbabwe, we have reached twelve very poor communities, some in remote areas. Hunger and deprivation are increasing progressively in our sad political situation, and we are now told that we are the second poorest nation on earth

### **KENYA**

Isiolo Empowerment Center is expanding TCD training to new villages.

### **NIGER**

We are training to reach UUPG's with TCD/CHE in Nigeria and Niger. They are aiming to choose the villages which will be used as a model village. We are giving them projectors and TCD lessons to engage every UUPG they adopt.

### **CÔTE D'IVOIRE**

### **GHANA**

### **EGYPT**

Many Nubians lived along the Nile, which curves northward through the desert. They speak the Nubian language, as well as Arabic. We trained 13 local committee members in a village called Adendan. They have chosen the head of the committee, the secretary, and financial officers. They discussed how they can use local resources to develop their community.

### **INDIA**

In this quarter, we were able to hold the first ever committee training in Kharibari Village, which was wonderful. This was a three-day training, and I am happy about the outcome. For most of the attendees, this was the first training of their lives of any kind.

### **TAJKISTAN**

In Kangurt Village, I have started to build relationships with people and research opportunities for future work. I went to Pushing Village for research and made good contact with three people there. In Hamadoni Village, a potential worker left to work in Russia. In Mastcho District in the north, there is a potential for starting work. There are three other villages near Dushanbe where I have good contacts and can start work there.

**NEPAL**

There is expansion in east Nepal. In February, we started work in the eastern part of Nepal in \*DG Village. We have identified 300-350 families to work with -- about 2000 people living in this village. Most of the villagers are from the poor Rshidev (Musahar) tribe of the oppressed Dalits community.
