We were humbled as we had so many delegates to the Poverty Challenge that we were given the Main Auditorium for our sessions. By the end of the meeting, we had 12 Million Village Challenge Consultations scheduled and our prayer goal was 10!! In the next 12 months we are expecting MVC Consultations to be held in the Middle East, Africa (East and West), South East Asia, The Balkans, and beyond.

PLANS FOR NEXT YEAR'S POVERTY CHALLENGE WILL GIVE US MORE TIME AND INTERACTION!

Dates: 21-24 October 2016 - New Delhi, India

21 October - Although the conference will start in the early evening, we will start in the *morning*. We will have 4-5 hours.

Our time will be split the first day into 2 groups:

~ New attendees so they can have an introduction to the Poverty Challenge

~ Returning Attendees for practical discussions on generating movements of rural transformation. The day will conclude with delegates sharing what kingdom events they are seeing that is bringing transformation to unreached villages.

22 October - We will have our normal 4 hours on this first full day of the conference. This day will focus on free tools available for MVC partners from international organizations followed by discussions on how to build momentum and networks for impacting every village in a region or country.

23 October - We will roll most of the delegates into the Business Sphere for the day with it split part of the day to:

- ~ Rural micro business discussions
- ~ Urban small business discussions and neighborhood partnerships for transformation.

Summary of speech by Ron Seck

FACT:

The theme of The Gathering Wave, MVC Conference reflects a global momentum of national partners to reach every unreached poor village with compassion and the love of Christ.

RESULTS TO EXPECT:

- ~ Vision Seminars in new areas of Community Based Development (CBD)
- Scheduled "Training of Trainers of CBD" for partners in new areas
- Creation of Regional Support Networks for helping partners with training, planning, model development and other free resources.

RECRUIT BY INVITATION ONLY to leaders who truly have a passion to help reach the unreached villages of their country, region.

A REAL MODEL of a transformed (or transforming) village, including site visitation

CREATE A SOLID COMMITTEE that supports the needs of the partners in the following ways:

- 1. Representing the MVC for the area to the Global MVC Transform World.
- 2. Nurturing new Field Team efforts with consultation and material support
- 3. Helping sponsor MVC, Vision Seminars, and Training in the region
- 4. Sharing available resources from regional/national partners
- 5. Providing further training for skill development of field trainers
- 6. Support development of intern programs for new leaders
- 7. Providing intentional fellowship, prayer, and encouragement
- 8. Identify ways for national workers to develop sustaining income for their livelihoods
