NEWS BRIEFS

AFGHANISTAN

A women's skills training and counseling center is proposed to help poor women and to expand their community based training to numerous clusters in Afghanistan! *Brother K*

ARMENIA

The House of Esther is launching CDE amongst refugees and local villages in the Spitak area. Also local villages of Yazidis and Kurds are getting engaged! *Brother D*

TAJIKISTAN

After just 2 years, the Model Village has already had a cluster effect and 5 new villages are seeking CDE training!! *Brother J*

SPAIN

Vision Seminar from 4 different Churches in Barcelona and Sant Cugat

We had around 18-20 people for a 1-1/2 day Vision Seminar. People were really encouraged with what they heard. 80% of them immediately said that they want to go through training because they want to use CDE principles in their ministries. *Sister M*

BOSNIA

Hungarian CDE team to do a seminar called "Developing Sustainable Partnership". *Sister M*

EGYPT

A new village cluster in Upper Egypt launches by helping women learn to prioritize their daily activities for their personal and family development. *Sister L*

WEST BANK

14 villages entered the cluster effect. A model was completed. A Village initiated projects including a medical clinic, cleaning of streets, an eye clinic, and a school teaching ethics! *Brother M*

JORDAN

Expansion to a new cluster. Also doors were opened via wheelchairs! *Brother R*

LEBANON

A breakthrough took place with CDE in refugee camps!! We are celebrating 2 years of TCD (Transformational Community Development) in Lebanon! *Brother J*

Also, we were happy to complete our second year of serving refugee women and children in Lebanon. This month, a conference took place for a week with attendance of more than 120 Syrian women and children.

WEST BANK

TCD was launched for House of Mary in Bethlehem. We also had the medical day for the people of Khellet Al-Haddad village, where we decided to do a Vision Meeting. *Brother G*

Ahumbe Aliade LGA of Benue State has been impacted by Dogon Gada in Kebbi State. The distance between these communities is 1300km. A TCD village is beginning in Ahumbe and TCD activities have commenced in other villages. *Brother M*

KENYA

A maturing model helps village engage local government. Support from the public administrators has increased advocacy for children’s rights to education. Their efforts to develop or change policy to meet the needs of children has brought about transformation. *Sister H*

INDONESIA

A remote village is now a training center for villages all over their region! A number of new models are hoped for as farmers from the whole region are now sending their young men for training. *Brother C*

MYANMAR

After just a few years of developing one of our models in a very dangerous area, it is having a cluster effect and local leaders from the model are key in helping understand CDE! *Brother S*

CAMBODIA

An amazing lady is now available to be a champion for CDE there!

VIETNAM

Extensive CDE impact to dozens of villages is now becoming a potential bridge into the MVC movement!

LAOS

A key leader and person of peace has been raised up to bring the Vision of helping poor villages into CDE!

INDIA

West Bengal village launches with a 9-member committee comprised of local women who really want to receive CDE training. After the formation, the committee decided to start a kitchen garden in the beginning of September. I expect it to be a small, but great beginning. *Brother S*

NEPAL

A cluster effect has taken place in our South West Model and now 20 village workers are taking CDE training!!

BHUTAN

Village workers are being given the Vision for CDE!!!!
