## **AFGHANISTAN**

The trees have grown well and many villagers in the region have observed how fast and well the trees have grown. GHNI workers are planning new village surveys and assessments and have been in contact with local government partners to make a good plan for next year. They are planning to start a women's centre and village TCD.

## **ETHIOPIA**

CHE MOVES WOMAN FROM SELLING CHAT TO SELLING MILK FOR A LIVING

Fetiha is living in Bisidimo Village. At 39 years old, she and her husband have four children. Before she joined GHNI's Transformational Community Development (TCD) group, she was selling chat for other people who hired her on a daily basis. The money she was earning was not enough to support her family and life was very difficult for them. When GHNI's organization was operating in the area, she was selected by the leaders of the community.

During the discussion with the community leaders, GHNI workers asked the leaders to recruit new TCD group members who were poor or lower income villagers. Fetiha was one of the women selected. After the selection, she became a member of the Agriculture and Income Generation groups. During discussion with her, Fetiha said she has seen great change in her life. She initially received three goats and now the number totals nine. Her children can get enough milk and she is also making good money from her harvest of more than 10,000 birr (about 300€; £270; or 360CHF). She is living a happy life now.

## **EGYPT**

SEED MEDICAL CLINIC EXPANDS INTO A NEW VILLAGE

A medical convoy was deployed to the village of Jezert Tama in Upper Egypt. The area suffers from poverty and disease and this village has suffered neglect for years. The medical convoy consisted of four doctors who examined about 85 villagers, including children. Sudanese refugees in nearby camps are now seeking TCD training as they see other villages transforming!! Praise the Lord!

## **MYANMAR**

MODEL VILLAGE EXPANDS BY CONDUCTING VISION SEMINARS IN THEIR AREA

Villagers in Myat Hlae will lead the expansion. This is why GHNI believed in equipping our local TCD workers to be able to train others would be vital for multiplication in that area. Our TCD lessons have gradually brought about change in the children and adults regarding their habits in light of their new knowledge.
