JAPAN

Serve the City (STC) International Ambassador Mr. Jerry McCARTY, Mr. Hal JONES, and a team of 9 International leaders were able to present STC in the context of a Million Village Vision Seminar for transformational work amongst poor communities. We were sobered to find out 1 child in 3 in Okinawa and 1 in 5 in Aomori were from poor families and malnourished. Leaders from both cities agreed to start collaboration for STC style work. Please pray for this! Follow up trips are scheduled for April next year. Mr. Charlie LAMENTO is coordinating the planned trip.

The old man said to me, "It doesn't matter what religion you are, but more importantly, what you are doing in this world." Many people, not only this old man, come and ask me about this. It is a powerful message of hope to these villagers.

NEPAL

KENYA

CDE POSITIONING FOR REGIONAL TRANSFORMATION

Starting about a decade ago amongst Oromo villages, no churches existed. Now over 50 churches exist, mostly with Pastors from a Muslim Background. Now several clusters are transforming and we are praying for complete transformation throughout the whole of the Oromo region!!

INDONESIA

MILLION VILLAGE CHALLENGE

Farmers in Sulawesi are using better locally based agriculture to impact more of their region! The TCD team was pleased to see the positive effect on the wider community and even in other communities. The core farmers were able to subsidize what they lacked from their own harvests by buying wet beans from scores of other farmers and then processing them along with their own. It was an arrangement that truly benefited all parties: the core farmers met their order quota, other farmers were able to sell their beans at a higher than market price without having to spend time and energy drying them (giving them more time and energy to focus on other income streams), and buyers received the quality they needed without having to buy through lengthy supply channels!

ETHIOPIA

CLUSTER EXPANSION!

Kito Village has had so much transformation that now the people are becoming self-sustainable in farming. Now they are able to pay for their children to go to school. As a result, nearby villagers are asking for the same teaching and CDE is being REQUESTED!!

EGYPT

UPPER EGYPT AROUND LUXOR IS EXPLODING!

Catalytic movements keying off of a few poor villages has recently resulted in TCD being taught in Luxor, German Hospital. In 6 villages of a cluster, now there are 26 committees with over 600 people! NEW TRIBE OPENS UP!! We will hold three sport days and also visit Shalatin, south of Aswan, to start working with the tribe of Basharya.
