It therefore is with the hope and prayer that we would like to invite you to the **Transform World Global Leadership Summit VII** to be held at the beautiful Oromia Cultural Centre, Addis Ababa, Ethiopia from November 6<sup>th</sup> afternoon to 9<sup>th</sup> noon, 2018. We will start our program at 5:00 pm at the Oromia Cultural Center.

## A Historical Place for a Historical Moment

Transform World Vision 2020 appeals to the Church to consider seven pressing issues of our time. It is a plea to servant leaders to engage in a Christ honoring response to the great challenges of our time. We come together to seek His face for united strategic action glorifying Him in every nation via every major sphere of cultural influence in every region of the world. Transformation is a journey that three generations must respond to through faith and prayer. Informed cohesive prayerful action with qualified global representation leads to a sustained global movement resulting in transformation. We believe **God has called you to be a part of this global transformation movement** and hence this personal invitation to you for the **Transform World Global Leadership Summit 2018**. **Challenge Response**: Ideological/Islam, Family, Orphan, Poverty, Justice, Christ's Missional & Celebration) so that we can expand the global efforts by sharing vision, best practices, strategic resources, and planning for real impact globally by 2020.

**Sphere Engagement**: Having a better understanding of our progress of love and work into the challenges we then want to focus on the Spheres (Arts, Business, Church, Delivery through Media, Education, Family & Government) where we can have global networking, momentum building, strategic planning and brainstorming to ensure that each sphere is gathering momentum for global transformational impact by 2020.

**Regional TW2020 Initiatives**: Based on our understanding of the needs and efforts in the Challenges, and the resources and leadership for broadening influence into every Sphere we will move to Regional Planning.

In addition, three generational collaboration emphasizing Gen Y and 4/14 Window.
