MACEDONIA

NEW MACEDONIAN CALL!!

Agron Aga, Jeannie, and I are just returning from Stip, Macedonia where we met with enthusiastic workers from the Galilee Foundation. This remarkable group of Macedonians have managed to plant and then minister to some 27 churches in the eastern, southern, and western parts of their nation over the last ten years. This was done largely without outside help.

We did a CHE TOT1 training with them in May and were now returning to help them clarify and write down their visions and plans for CHE projects. They are looking for partners to help them launch up to 9 CHE projects through their churches and in communities around where they have church plants. They will utilize several CHE models and are highly disciplined and motivated. Their long-term goal is to reach

unreached communities throughout all of Macedonia with the Gospel and the ministry of CHE. The target group includes Macedonians, Roma, and Muslims who are among the poorest of the poor and most unreached in their country.

They demonstrated this clearly when Okoro visited Blamonga recently. The village head was away on a short trip, but he delegated a representative to show Okoro and Lenle the parcel of land made available for the school project. Not only that, they signed land papers by way of documentation to establish that the land is for TCD and not for any other purpose.

NEPAL

NEPAL VILLAGE QUICKLY BECOMING A MODEL!

A Short Term Trip volunteer team, led by GHNI CEO Hal Jones, came to visit DG Village in March. They went to farmers' houses and were encouraged and happy to see the cleanliness of the poor village. GHNI's women's literacy class, children's education centre, and wellness programme are so helpful to the community. They could easily see the progress toward becoming a model village in the coming days.

We saw new toilets constructed in the village where before there was not a single toilet in the whole community. Villagers have started small business stores, some started raising goats, and others started vegetable farming. All of this transformation was so encouraging!

KENYA

KENYA RESETTLED VILLAGE FROM TRIBAL CONFLICT PURSUES TCD!

The Attir community passed through hard times after tribal clashes between Attir Village and its neighbours. It was just one of the communities which was affected by inter-tribal wars. The villagers were displaced from their original homes and went and stayed in a camp for almost six months. Children had nowhere to go and stayed at home all day long without being in school. After some six months, the area got settled and the problem of tribal clashes was fully settled, and peace was restored. Villagers went back to their homes, but the children could not resume learning because the small classroom which was used as a nursery had been destroyed.

When GHNI stepped into Attir, the first thing we noted was that the children were all over the village and none went to school. We taught the community the importance of education for the children. The first step was to create a school committee which would deal with the matters of education in the village. The community took the initiative to build a semi-temporary structure so that the young children could begin classes.

SRI LANKA SEED VILLAGE OPENS DOOR VIA CHILDREN'S EDUCATION!

We have just opened a tutoring class in WR Village and built a tutoring place to accommodate children with shelter from the sun and rain. We purchased second-hand tables and benches to keep the cost low.

AFGHANISTAN

AFGHANISTAN WOMEN LEADING THE WAY TO EXPANSION OF TCD\CHE

Recently, the GHNI-Afghanistan team has developed a strategy to meet one of the biggest needs of the country—to help the women. Accordingly, GHNI has decided to start several Women's Centres. First of all, we plan to start a couple of centres in a rural region. The main purpose is to provide economic empowerment for the women. We will be providing training and opportunities to produce and sell handicrafts. However, another key is to train the women in the benefits of and how to produce a kitchen garden. This will allow the women to provide diverse vegetables for their family, cutting down on their food budgets, but also enable them to sell the extra produce to supplement their household income. We will also promote health and education opportunities through these centres.
