**MILLION VILLAGE CHALLENGE CONFERENCE AT TRANSFORM WORLD HOSTED 51 GLOBAL LEADERS!**

We were thrilled with the news and new resources being shared by so many partners of MVC in Addis Ababa last week.

As you know, we are praying in the Million Village Challenge that by 2020 we will have 10,000 Model Villages strategically placed amongst the poor unreached. We believe these will influence about 100,000 villages. This would be nearly creating a 10% tipping point for total acceptance of CDE/CHE/TCD concepts by the estimated 1 million poorest villages of the world.

Research Classifications for the Million Village Challenge

We are seeing the emergence of transformational movements around the globe that begin with a single model village, multiply to other villages nearby (the village cluster), and then transform whole districts. Inspired by what we are seeing; we are doing research aimed at classifying where existing CDE/CHE/TCD programs are in the process of catalyzing a movement.

The purpose of our research is to ensure that we see a transformational movement among the village in every state of every developing country by 2020. Our goal is 10,000 model villages that have begun the process of multiplication into clusters. As we reported last month, we estimate that we are about 40% of the way there.

The research classifications below seek to help us understand and measure the MVC impact in each state. We see five levels, or stages, in the process that form the acronym ASCOT. We are not asking participants in the Million Village Challenge to limit themselves to these indicators but will use them as general guidelines for measuring our progress in the Million Village Challenge.

A AWARENESS

We are **Aware** that CDE/CHE/TCD is being initiated in a state, but workers are still in the preparation or entry stages with little activity yet in the village.

S STARTING

Teams have **Started** work in a community and a village committee has been formed.

C CHANGING

A village is Changing. Projects are being done by the committee and lessons taught through group meetings and/or home visits.

O OPENING

A cluster is Opening. A village is developing as a model and beginning to multiply to the villages around it.

T TRANSFORMATION

Transformation is visible in the following sectors, according to WWIFE C!

- **Water:** Within a fifteen-minute walk of each residence.
- **Wellness and Sanitation:** Pit latrines and dish racks are visible and used. All children are vaccinated. Children are healthy.
- **Income:** Micro business is thriving and contributing to family income.
- **Food Security:** Agriculture is productive and family has reserves.
- **Education:** All children are in school through the 6th grade.
- **Community** of multiplying followers of Jesus.

(The above outcomes are widely expected by foundations and granting organizations, but do not define the totality of Biblical transformation. We also want to see outcomes such as a Christian worldview that respects the dignity and vocation of all people made in the image of God, peace, justice, compassion, and righteousness. We might even add to that safe housing, roads and infrastructure, and electrification. For these reasons we cannot use these indicators to limit the work of any village ministry, but will use them to measure progress for the sake of the Million Village Challenge).

The classifications above will serve to measure progress toward our goal, which is better defined by them. What is our goal?

Our goal is 10,000 open clusters (see "O" in ASCOT) strategically placed in every state throughout the developing world by 2020, including one open cluster in targeted unreached people groups.

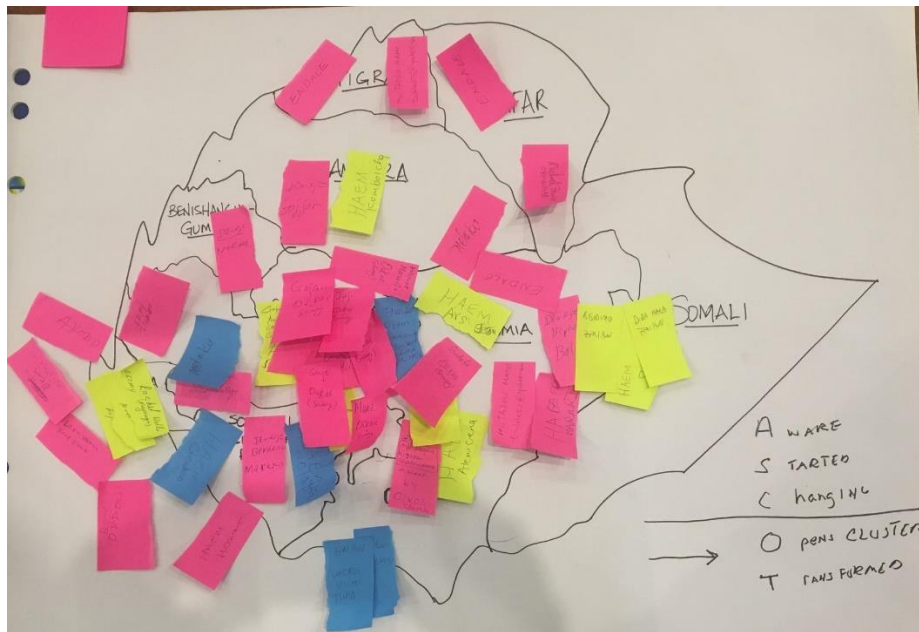
To begin our research, we are hoping in the next year to have regional and national meetings to identify the following:

1. Which states have no awareness
2. Which states have villages that are starting or changing
3. Which states have model villages and open clusters
4. Which states have a multiplying transformational movement

We hope that by providing all of the participating collaborating agencies this information, we will dramatically accelerate the establishment of models and the catalyzing of transformational movements with the potential to reach a tipping point and impact whole nations.

Here is a visual of how this might work:

Terry Dalrymple led a consultation in Addis Ababa of Ethiopian CHE leaders in an MVC planning session. Great joy was expressed by many as they gathered around the map on the floor in Ethiopia and placed 3 colored sticky notes to signify their commitment



1. Yellow sticky notes – places where work was **Starting** or **Changing**
2. Blue sticky notes – where there was either an **Open Cluster** or **Transformation**.
3. Pink sticky notes – where there was a real commitment to start a model by 2020.

What a joy it was to see these leaders move prayerfully and rapidly to take action. God had definitely prepared their hearts, and a strong sense of the Spirit's presence fell upon the room as they worked. In a matter of hours, they set a goal of 520 villages (52 clusters), mapped them out on a map of the country, and identified strategic locations they wanted to begin work in each of Ethiopia's 9 districts. Since that meeting, they have formed a national committee and have scheduled the first TOT (Training of Trainers) for next month for about 15 leaders of different ministries based in Addis Ababa that were in the room and requested it. Thank you, Jesus!
