Training and Networking Leaders to Transform their Nations

Merry Christmas!

2018 was one of our best years yet. Here is a look back.

The Global Transformation Network has leadership teams in about 40 countries and is served by our global facilitators in different world regions. Some of the regional facilitators (in Latin America and Europe) traveled to serve in other nations. In addition, GTN president Mark Beliles, based in USA, served these teams as well

In 2018, Dr. Beliles was able to go on 20 trips to other countries. Two brand new countries he visited were Ghana and Ethiopia. Plus, he went twice to Costa Rica to develop a new team for the first time in that nation. In addition to these he returned to the Asian countries of Singapore, Indonesia and Philippines. And he returned to Colombia, Ecuador, Chile and Brazil in South America. Beliles also attended a conference in met leaders in Switzerland. (See Ghana and Costa Rica pics below)



Latin America with its facilitators Maria Irene Squillaci in Bolivia and Ron Diaz in Costa Rica is our strongest region. Colombia held its first national convention of GTN leaders and a strong board and volunteer team from various cities was affirmed there to work with August Bernal of Bogota. Senator Jhon Milton Rodriguez

of Colombia was able to join with Beliles as speakers in Ecuador to inspire a transformation movement there. Beliles was publicly honored by the national Congress of Chile when he visited that nation. (See below left of Colombia GTN convention and right of Beliles speaking in Chile Congress building).



Prior to this year only Latin America and USA had our current books available in print. But Southeast Asia had major progress in getting books printed there for ongoing use in 3 countries. Beliles was honored to be part of important meetings in Singapore organized by Juliette Arulrajah, and in Philippines by BG Hernandez, and in Indonesia by Rio Sibarani and Iman Santoso.

Southeast Asia also significantly developed their leadership teams and networks, so that now Southeast Asia, Latin America, and USA are among GTN's strongest areas both in transformation teams and tools. But Europe has also developed a team that is starting to make an impact through the co-leadership of David Koerts in Netherlands and Viktor Matveyev in Ukraine. Africa has been the least developed but at a Transform World summit in Ethiopia, some of the African GTN leaders were there and began to develop plans together. In addition, Mark Beliles had a great meeting in Ghana and was pleasantly surprised to see at least our older books there still available in print. Plus, conversations with leaders in South Africa show great potential.

GTN had a great summit mainly for North America in September in Dallas, TX but which also drew people from about 15 other nations. It was done mainly in partnership with Dennis Peacocke of the Statesmen Project, but also sponsored and attended by people from Transform World and Disciple Nations Alliance. Peacocke and Beliles also did joint events in Costa Rica, Ecuador and Colombia. GTN's Beliles also helped with the Transform World Global Summit in Ethiopia (convened by Luis Bush) in November, and with the world conference of the International Coalition of Apostolic Leaders (convened by John Kelly) in USA in November. Hundreds of global leaders gathered in these events from about 100 nations in all. (see below Beliles and Matveyev of Ukraine, and with Peacocke & Kelly)



GTN president Beliles spoke directly to about 100,000 people this year in these events. He is excited to see the increasing transformational impact of the church of Jesus Christ in the nations. In 2019 Beliles will visit Australia for the first time. Plus, a major Latin America Christian political leaders meeting will occur in March just after the Disciple Nations Alliance global forum. Significant merging and aligning of resources between Statesmen Project and GTN will be done as well. The September 5-7 international summit of GTN (in USA, Dallas, TX) is being planned now and we hope you can be a part of it. Plus we are helping with an International Church Council event in Zurich, Switzerland in July.


The Global Transformation Network is convening an International Church Council to help define and unify the global church on key theological points for the future transformation of the nations for Christ.
