NUBIA

Nubian unreached people group engaged through lessons on forgiveness in SEED PROJECT! Praise God for what happened in inner healing seminar, how God healed broken hearts. At a time of sharing, they declared forgiveness for those who were wounded and shared about their relationships with God. Although they are Muslim, they learned in the seminars that the relationship with God is a love affair not a fear. Their faces differed after the healing and the joy filled their hearts and they danced to the tune of Nubia songs. We now follow up with them by a training team in Nubia.

UPG in Farwest Nepal seeks help! There is lots of progress on the work and the goat raising program still continues by the committee. They are requesting GHNI to continue it. Close by this area, another village was identified where Dalit of the Dalit’s community Badi live. Badi people have no land and their house. They are called people who entertain other people. As they don’t have any jobs, they are called sex workers. Their profession is sex work. They are a vulnerable group of people for human trafficking and abuse. I would love to take our team there and start TCD there. They have requested us to provide some income generation opportunities.

MESOAMERICA

MISSIONS EFFORTS ARE PRIMED FOR CHE IN THE GREAT COMMISSION

Dr. Hugo GOMEZ writes: Christians involved in cross-cultural missions in Mesoamerica and beyond should consider the Community Health Evangelism (CHE) approach which applies such Core Values as:

1. Integration of the physical and spiritual
2. Multiplication
3. Community ownership
4. Development rather than relief

CHE contextualizes (without compromising the Truth) among most of the classifications and sub-classifications of “ethnos,” gradually overcoming all the known barriers. CHE facilitates the process to Biblical wholism, development, and transformation, which then allows for abundant life in Jesus Christ by breaking cycles of poverty (physical, social, spiritual) for peoples who will open their cultures. In the Global CHE Network, we have members reaching “ethnos” among open, closed, and “creative access” countries. They are Spirit-led in their use of a great variety of approaches including: community-based, church-based, church-initiated, government-based, and family-based approaches. CHE also includes elements of pre-evangelism with moral values teachings as well as full discipleship. Through these approaches we are witnessing individuals, families, communities, and clusters of villages walk in the process of one day becoming “reached and engaged.” This is the outcome of working the Great Commission and the Great Commandment together, due to the Great Need of the people and because of the Great Example of Jesus. But it takes a Great Commitment to go in His methodology of teaching, preaching, and healing.

MACEDONIA

NEW CHE TEAM FOR MACEDONIA!

MAI announced: Praise the Lord there is a new CHE (Community Health Evangelism) team in Macedonia! Patriot, along with our partners from CHE Albania, and CHE EuropeNet have been to Macedonia several times to conduct a Vision Seminar and a Training of Trainers I seminar. On their latest trip they helped the Macedonians from several churches form a CHE training team that will use CHE as a tool to reach out and serve their communities.

CAMEROON

MODEL VILLAGE DEVELOPING

Located in West Africa, Cameroon is home to the village of Guidiguis. This village, once it is self-sustainable, will serve as a model village and training center to villages in the surrounding areas. Populated by the hard working Tupuri tribe, predominantly subsistent farmers, they are sandwiched amidst many tribes. Yet, they are willing to encounter transformation. It is strategic in bringing transformation to other tribes within the surrounding region, with the hope to one day eradicate cyclical poverty in Cameroon.

IRAQ

YAZIDI VILLAGE STARTS TCD

After four years of exile, the Yazidi families we serve cannot return home. There are physical barriers, such as no running and clean water and limited electricity. Most of their homes are destroyed and they can't earn enough money for their daily lives, much less to rebuild. Moreover, there are leftover mines and booby traps. Neighbors who joined with violent groups who seek to kill and enslave them still live there. There also remain various groups in power that do not have good intentions toward the Yazidi. Please remember these exiled people as they learn TCD and prepare to move to new villages.
