### GENEVA

Terry Dalrymple, Servant Leader of the Global CHE Network, will speak on how CHD/TCD/CDE is to be the centerpiece of eliminating rural poverty. Law and policy makers from 20-30 and 10-40 window countries will attend, along with many others in Geneva at the Geneva Institute for Leadership and Public Policy on 18-21 June 2019. The theme this year is National Transformation through Poverty Alleviation.

The House of Esther, used as a training center and housing for Syrian Refugees, made a great impression on local Armenian villages. Now a new village project has started with locally trained Armenians: TCD Spitak Jurashen has commenced!

The Armenia momentum has produced a TOT1/TCD Training for delegates from Iran, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, etc. It is scheduled in the House of Esther in Spitak, Armenia 21-26 May. Some scholarships are available.

A village of ex-slaves, we call The Overcomer's Village, has commenced in South West Nepal on the border with India. Released from a slaver a generation ago, they went to the river and were exploited and became known as sex workers, living in dire poverty. A vision seminar and health screening clinic convinced the village to move towards poverty alleviation, hopefully ending generations of being poor and exploited.

### **SOUTH AFRICAN TRAINING BRINGS AMAZING BLESSING IN UNITY, A STORY**

During a vision seminar for spiritual leaders in a rural township in South Africa, we could share the vision of wholistic TCD with pastors from Roman Catholic to Pentecostal. That morning God touched the hearts of the pastors while tears were flowing. Here is what one said:

"If we are honest, we are building our own little kingdoms. We are not prepared to forgive. We're jealous. We're also, as pastors, visiting the sangoma (witchdoctor). We complain about jobs, but we are too lazy to work. We turned away from what He called us for in our community. We have to turn around again, start praying and fasting together and trust Him again."

Commitments to join hands and come together for prayer and fasting were made. God prepared the hearts for starting the process of wholistic TCD in this township. Because if the hearts are not changed, *none* of the community development work will be sustainable. Thanks for His intervention!

## **CAMEROON**

Extreme north state is vast majority Muslim, especially in the poor villages. A Million Village Vision Seminar was conducted. Over 60 leaders came from many denominations. Over 30 villages were adopted and 3 villages commenced work in CHE/TCD/CDE.

## **CHAD**

African partnerships were developed when 160 denominational leaders and village workers came together to a Million Village Vision Seminar. 68 villages were adopted. TOT1/TCD is scheduled in the next quarter.

A new village cluster in West Bengal India is coming as a result of the model village: Binodpur. Reports are that the committees are hitting the ground running. All nationally locally led.

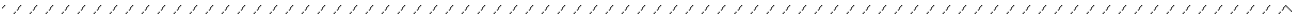
