Warm Greetings in His name!

We are grateful for the prayerful response to the Transform World 2020 Vision and look to the Lord Jesus Christ to continue to lead and guide as the affirmed CEO of the TW 2020 vision. The TW 2020 Summit I was held in Bali in 2012 and summits have been held on an annual basis since that date in Kansas City, Geneva/Macon, Seoul, Bangkok, Guayaquil and most recently in Addis Ababa. It is therefore with the hope and prayer that we would like to invite you to the Transform World Global Leadership Summit VIII to be held in Melbourne, Australia from October 15 to 18, 2019. We will start our program at 4:30 pm at Bethany International Church and you are advised to check in our arranged and confirmed hotels by midday on October 15 and checkout before midday on October 18, unless you are choosing to extend your stay for personal reasons.

A Historical Place for a Historical Moment

Transform World Vision 2020 appeals to the Church to consider seven pressing global issues of our time. It is a plea to servant leaders to engage in a Christ honoring response to these great challenges. We come together to seek His face for united strategic action glorifying Him in every nation via every major sphere of cultural influence in every region of the world. Transformation is a journey that three generations must respond to through faith and prayer. Informed cohesive prayerful action with qualified global representation leads to a sustained global movement resulting in transformation.

We believe **God has called you to be a part of this global transformation movement** and hence we extend this personal invitation to you for the **Transform World Global Leadership Summit VIII**. To build a fruitful movement of transformation we need to continue to grow deeper in understanding of God's purposes, in our love for each other and our demonstration of unity.

Objectives of the Leadership Summit

We have identified five critical objectives that we will be seeking to address in our time together in Melbourne: - worship, prayer, challenge response, sphere response, and regional engagement.

Worship: We want to prevail in this posture in all things. We desire to keep our vision fresh as we hear what the Lord is doing and will receive reports from leadership team members for each region, sphere, and challenge.

Prayer for the Transformation of South Pacific and beyond: We will make time to bless the Oceanic countries that form the "ends of the earth" and have so much potential to be a blessing to the rest of the world.

Challenge Response: We will reflect on the seven global challenges (Ideological/Islam, Family, Orphan, Poverty, Justice, Christ's Missional & Celebration) so that we can expand the global efforts through collaboration, planning and the sharing of vision, best practices and strategic resources for real impact globally.

Sphere Engagement: Having a better understanding of our progress of love and work into the challenges we also want to focus on the Spheres (Arts, Business, Church, Media, Education, Family and Government) where we can have global networking, momentum building, strategic planning and brainstorming to ensure that each sphere is gathering momentum for global transformational impact.

Regional TW2020 Initiatives: Based on our understanding of the needs and efforts in the Challenges, and the resources and leadership for broadening influence into every Sphere we will move to address initiatives from a Regional perspective.

In addition, there will be opportunities for collaboration across the three generations with an emphasis on Gen Y and the 4/14 Window. We encourage invited delegates to consider bringing a younger emerging leader with them to the summit by even personally supporting for paying registration fees.

An early bird international participant cost for the conference other than international travel cost, which is personally borne, will start from USD250 in a 2 Bedroom apartment at Experience Aria Hotel Apartment (www.staywitharia.com.au), and from USD290 per person in a 2 Bedroom apartment at Experience Bella Hotel Apartment (www.experiencehotels.com.au), located about 500 meters from the venue - Bethany International Church (www.bethanymelb.org.au) The rooms at both Aria and Bella Hotel Apartments are available on a first come first served basis. Scholarships will be offered for limited number of delegates who are assessed as being unable to afford all the fees. Delegates from countries listed in https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/The World Factbook list of developed countries, will not be entitled to apply for scholarships. We will also have separate registration for Australian and South Pacific participants.
