NIGERIA

We organized two webinars. One of them connected with medical doctors from London England and Maryland USA. Mr. Martins ATANDA was also a speaker to address the reality of COVID 19 and the dynamic changes it has brought to the living realities of the average man in the cities and rural communities. The participants requested further webinar sessions for updates. The second webinar was held for church leaders in Sokoto and other participants joined online. The goal was to sensitize the church leaders so they can look beyond the pain of not holding regular church meetings but to consider the health situation of their members. The church leaders opined that the ministry of health needed to educate religious leaders in a proactive way rather than the general pattern of educating all.

These religious leaders have more access to their members.

NIGERIA and BURKINA FASO

Champions of some villages went to reiterate the teachings on hand washing.

This hygiene practice is further and critically needed due to the infections of COVID 19.

We started making face masks through our Women Empowerment Centers.

The women took the sewing machines home and are producing these masks from the comfort of their homes for their communities.

We also asked the health and wellness committees to engage in liquid soap making to enhance the ritual of hand washing for rural dwellers because many will wash hands without using soap or detergent. We are embarking on multiplying the hand washing stations beyond locating them near the latrines. We are also placing them in both public and private places like the market and squares used for gathering, gaming, and relaxation and beyond to street corners and private residences where it is open for community dwellers.

EGYPT

6 More Villages Opened Up to CHE/TCD/CDE in Upper Egypt COVID 19 Seminars Planned for Upper Egypt

Cairo slum village Helwan takes double hit of flood and COVID 19 and miraculously receives double blessings of relief and opportunity!

Helwan area: A flood destroyed the whole area on March 11 including our center. Many families lost their homes, their belongings, and their clothes. There were about 21 deaths and loss of people. Then the COVID 19 crisis happened and the situation worsened. But God helped us (the team in Egypt) to collect an amount of money and we started partnerships with other organizations. We were able to provide 175 blankets, 100 boxes of food supplies, clothes for 100 families, and 350 water bottles.

AFGHANISTAN

New Villages Connected via Women's Empowerment Centers

As our Women's Empowerment Center II (WEC II) moves forward, many new girls are coming to the center to learn the English language. Some of these girls come from villages which are more than an hour away from the center!

HOLY LAND

Launches New Initiative Including Self-Sustaining Training

We started a new project named Holy Land Gardens! This project is agriculturally based and creates a training facility for individuals with special needs. We are in the beginning phase of relocating the greenhouse due to a unique set of circumstances. Since we are in the middle of the prime agricultural season, we hope to use the greenhouse now in a nursery setting.

KENYA

New Villages Engaging TCD via Women's Empowerment Center in Isiolo

The program is bringing tremendous transformation in the lives of so many young women from

different villages surrounding Isiolo, speaking all tribal languages represented in Isiolo. Right now, we have grown from tailoring and dressmaking to beautiful hair salons.

MYANMAR

Food Crisis Looms in CHE/TCD/CDE Villages as a Result of Civil War

Our TCD partners in Western Myanmar are in a desperate situation. The on-going conflict between the Arakan Army and Burmese Military has escalated in recent weeks, with an expected peak in fighting in Paletwa Township to occur this week. Thousands of Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) have flooded Paletwa town and local food stocks have been depleted, tripling the price of rice in local markets.
