Dear Servant of the Most High God,

Warm greetings in His name!

We are in unprecedented times. The COVID-19 virus has spread from Asia to Europe and North America rapidly over the past months, bringing with it a level of panic and angst—everywhere from the supermarket to the stock market to the local church—not seen in recent times. God is calling us to enter a new dimension – out of our comfort zone – to discern His will for our time and our generation.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions beyond our imagination, we are shifting this year's **Transform World Global Leadership Summit IX**, previously to be held in Indonesia from 20-23 October 2020, to a **VIRTUAL SUMMIT from 20-22 October 2020**.

This year's summit is a continuation of the previous Transform World summits, previously held in Bali (2012), Kansas City (2013), Geneva/Macon (2014), Seoul (2015), Bangkok (2016), Guayaquil (2017), Addis Ababa (2018), and most recently in Melbourne (2019).

Other than being our first-time ever to have this kind of summit virtually, this year's Transform World Global Leadership Summit IX will be a special celebration for all of us as 2020 is the closing year of the 2nd Phase of Transform World movement that started in 2012. We are going to use this summit to reflect what the Lord has done for the past 8 years as well as celebrate and give thanks to the Lord for the teamwork and the works of the Holy Spirit in every sphere/challenge/region.

A Historical Gathering for a Historical Moment

The Transform World Movement pursued **Connections during 2005-2011**, as the 1st Phase of the global movement, beginning with Indonesia, India, South Korea, and the United States, etc. in order to promote the transformation that God wants for His workers around the world. This was followed by repentance, prayer, meetings for unity, and large gatherings, with the goal of realizing the kingdom of God in the seven spheres of cultural society.

In the 2nd Phase, the '**Transform World 2020 Movement**' that lasts from 2012 till 2020, has been focusing on the seven practical challenges through the lenses of the ten regions and the three generations in addition to the existing seven spheres. This movement appeals to the Church to consider seven pressing global issues of our time. It is a plea to servant leaders to engage in a Christ-honoring response to these great challenges. Informed cohesive prayerful action with qualified global representation has led to a sustained global movement resulting in transformation.

We believe **God has called you to be a part of this global transformation movement** and hence we extend this personal invitation to you for the final **Transform World Global Leadership Summit IX**. To complete the 2nd Phase movement of transformation we need to continue to grow deeper in an understanding of God's purposes, in our love for each other and our demonstration of unity.

Objectives of the Leadership Summit

We have identified five critical objectives that we will be seeking to address in our time together virtually: - worship, prayer, challenge-response, sphere response, and regional engagement.

- **Worship:** We want to prevail in this posture in all things. We desire to keep our vision fresh as we hear what the Lord is doing and will receive reports from leadership team members for each region, sphere and challenge.
- **Challenge-Response:** We will reflect on the seven global challenges (Ideological/Islam, Family, Orphan, Poverty, Justice, Christ's Missional, and Celebration) so that we can expand the global efforts through collaboration, planning and the sharing of vision, best practices and strategic resources for real impact globally.
- **Sphere Engagement:** Having a better understanding of our progress of love and work into the challenges we also want to focus on the Spheres (Arts, Business, Church, Media, Education, Family, and Government) where we can have global networking, momentum building, strategic planning and brainstorming to ensure that each sphere is gathering momentum for global transformational impact.
- **Regional TW2020 Initiatives:** Based on our understanding of the needs and efforts in the Challenges, and the resources and leadership for broadening influence into every Sphere we will move to address initiatives from a regional perspective.
- In addition, there will be opportunities for collaboration across the **three generations with an emphasis on Gen Y and the 4/14 Window**. We encourage invited delegates to consider inviting a younger emerging leader with them to the summit.
