



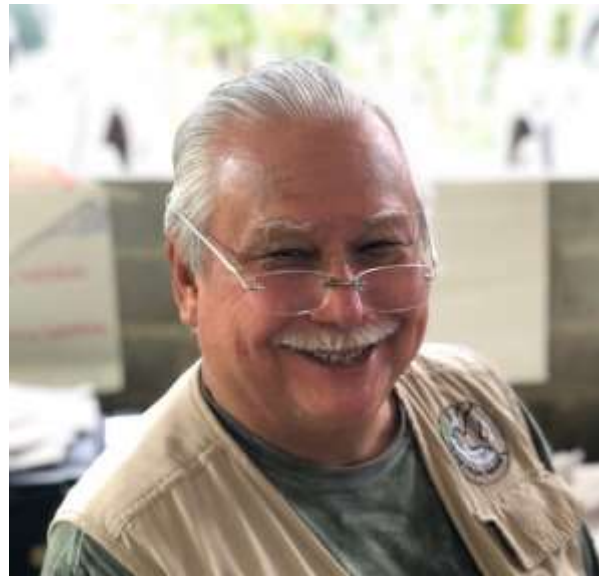

**Honorable Harold "Hal" JONES**

**15 October 1947 - 27 October 2020**

It is with heavy hearts that we notify you of the untimely, too-soon, and sudden passing of the Honorable Harold "Hal" JONES into the heavenly kingdom. On October 25, Hal suffered a massive heart attack. He died on October 27. Please pray for the Lord to comfort the broken hearts of his wife Lana of 52 years, their 4 children (Adam, Kehaulani, Aaron, and Noelani), their spouses, and their 14 grandchildren.

### **A few highlights of Hal's life (besides those mentioned in the legacy below):**

- ~ As a boy, Hal cleaned the office of a successful Hawaii businessman who later became the GHNI-US Board Chairman.
- ~ Hal served in the US Navy for two years, losing friends during the Vietnam War, and four more years in the Reserves.
- ~ While raising their four children, Hal and Lana started working in Real Estate. In less than five short years, under his dynamic, capable, and always faith-filled leadership, their business became the top ERA Real Estate office in America!
- ~ After their children were raised, Hal and Lana walked away from all of those worldly riches to serve the poor all over the world, igniting others. Often people would say, "Hal could encourage anyone into stepping out of their comfort zone" through his sincerity and quiet, unyielding, and jovial nature.

We have no doubt that Hal heard those longed-for words:

"Well done, my good and faithful servant."

Then, he likely fell into the loving arms of his Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, the lover of Hal's soul. Hal used every day of his life to honor Jesus and bring Him to be known by as many people as possible, but especially the hidden and hurting. As condolences pour in from all across the globe, we are further committed to honor Hal's legacy by continuing in the work to bring help and hope to the hidden and hurting. Especially to bring real HOPE to every last person on earth.

### **TRAILBLAZING HOPE-CATALYST FINISHES HIS EARTHLY RACE!**

Globe-Trotting and Hope-Igniting Realistic Visionary who consistently radiated the joy and love of Jesus everywhere he stepped foot all around the world, Honorable Harold JONES or more popularly known as Hal, recently and suddenly returned home to glory to be eternally at rest with Jesus in the fullness of joy even as he leaves behind a legacy of God's grace rippling far beyond his beloved family, circles of friends, nation, and various ministries he led!

As his eldest son Adam succinctly puts it,  
"He lived every day in the light of what God was leading him  
to do instead of what the world wanted. He left behind his  
personal priorities to find ways to make God a priority  
for the benefit of the whole world."

A hero of God's kingdom, Hal always sought to walk the talk by living out biblical principles as he aspired to keep in step with the Holy Spirit for God's purposes and glory!

The much-loved Hal, who is hailed as "family" by numerous ones of different ethnicities, cultures, and faiths because he touched hearts and lives, was the President of Global Hope Network International, a Swiss NGO in Special Consultative Status with the UN Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC). Hal co-founded GHNI with his equally passionate wife of 52 years, Lana, to "bring help and hope to the hidden and hurting" working to foster sustainable development programmes in hundreds of communities across Africa, Asia, and the Middle East as well as empowering peace and reconciliation in various parts of the globe.

As Transform World International's board member and voluntarily serving as International Facilitator for Poverty Alleviation, Hal had always led by example as God's ambassador of hope by simply living, serving, and reaching out to peoples of different ethnicities in their own contexts as any noteworthy servant leader would do.

He gave selflessly even as he continued to mobilize catalysts and leaders for positive transformation of society. Indeed, Hal has been a trailblazer of keeping the faith, poverty alleviation, breakthroughs, and world changes by tenaciously running the race in trusting God, sowing seeds, taking the initiative, seeing beyond the visible and opening doors to make possible the impossible!

As President of the UN-related Geneva Institute of Leadership and Public Policy (GILPP), in partnership with UNITAR, he envisioned and implemented training, curriculum, and strategies over the last 11 years for GILPP to equip and empower decision-making leaders and policy makers especially from emerging nations on critical contemporary global issues, equipping them to return to their countries and help fight for positive transformation in the public sphere toward prosperity, peace, and liberty! Hal was elected 3 times to the Hawaii State House of Representatives who served In the Hawaii Legislature from 1982-1988 and was named “Legislator of the Year” for the nation in 1986 by the American Legislative Exchange Council.



As an encourager of people and champion of the younger generation with an eye and heart to grooming younger leaders and an enthusiastic hands-on approach, Hal was a friendly and wise advisor and mentor who went out of his way to be there for loads of people including myself. He displayed great compassion for the poor, the marginalized, the underprivileged, and the migrants, underscoring and advocating how important it was to treat them with dignity even as we learn from and empower them.

I have such wonderful memories with and of Hal both at Transform World, where we served together, and at GILPP. He in many ways was a mentor and friend to me.

Thank you so very much, Hal! I am praising God for you and looking forward to more chats in heaven in the future in the Presence of our Loving Heavenly Father!

Please uphold Lana, their 4 children, their spouses, and 14 grandchildren in prayer. May God's Presence, Love, Strength, Shalom & Comfort uplift them!

Hal was an excellent man of exemplary character, innovative strategist, courageous

fighter for justice, humble servant leader, with an overflowing heart of gold, oozing compassion and love. Hal was the uplifter of the many, radiantly brimming over with joy, and leaving positive transformational imprints on countless lives and thousands of villages in Asia, Africa, the Americas, the Middle East, and around the globe.

His desire was for all people to have HOPE and fullness of life.

He became a tremendous blessing to the world!
