

The Path to a Million Villages-

A Message from Terry Dalrymple



In the Psalms, David frequently spoke of paths in his life. In Psalm 25:7, he asks of the Lord to "Show me your, ways, Lord, teach me your paths". When I think of paths, I often reflect on a path in Papua New Guinea which brought peace to two warring tribes because of the work of Community Health Evangelists. We, as a church, have a path to follow--The Great Commission to go to the ends of the earth with the gospel. We have a clear path ahead and will follow God's lead.

In order to achieve our goal of gospel-driven

community transformation in a million villages, we will all need to work together to mobilize and equip local ministries around the world to catalyze movements of change among the rural poor. **From start to finish that will involve:**

1. Holding Million-Village Consultations

Million-village consultations bring ministry leaders from a country or region and challenge them to adopt villages and pledge to initiate transformational community development work in those villages. MVC consultations have already been conducted in Western Europe and the Balkans, South Asia, Southeast Asia, West Africa, East Africa, the Middle East, and Latin America. As a result of these consultations, local ministries have adopted more than 19,000 villages in 65 different countries.

2. Equipping local ministry staff


Facilitating trasnformation in village communities will require both training and preparation as well as a three year commitment to facilitate transformational development in the target communities.
