



Severe flooding has affected one-third of Pakistan, including the Sindh province where a Million Village Consultation was held last spring and 240 villages were adopted. As I write, thousands of people have been displaced and many villages which CHE/TCD teams have been instrumental in serving are now wiped out. As of yesterday, we learned from one of our partners on the ground:



- 1300 people have died
- 30 Million people have been affected
- 10 Million people are homeless
- 800,000 livestock have died
- One Million houses have washed away
- 40+ small dams have been breached

The CHE/TCD Coordinator in Pakistan, “Adi”, who hosted our Million Village Consultation just five months ago wrote:

Please pray for me and my team, most of our model villages are gone and we have settled the people on the road and providing them food every day. Please pray for strength for me and my team. We are planning to provide the hygiene kits and mosquito nets. Please pray for provision. Soon winter will also start, we need warm clothes for kids as well.

A dear friend who has worked in Pakistan wrote me of “Adi’s” commitment to the community:

The situation continues to be disastrous. “Adi” continues to help those underwater. He barely has time to breathe. He and his team are amazing. Unfortunately, many of the places we visited in the spring are completely destroyed.

While the Million Village Challenge focuses on development, we want to assist our teams when they are hit with a catastrophic event. Would you pray for the Pakistani people in their distress? Pray for Christian workers as they reach out to serve people around them. Would you consider a gift to help at this time?
